SMJ EDITORIAL FELLOWSHIP

Call for Applicants

The Singapore Medical Journal is pleased to launch the SMJ Editorial Fellowship. The program aims to engage and expose promising early clinician researchers to journal editorial processes during the initial stages of their academic journey. Fellows will have hands-on training in the editorial and publishing processes and participate in discussions about research study design, data validity, novelty, potential impact, among others. Fellows will also be invited to conduct reviews of manuscripts under the guidance of their mentors and have the opportunity to co-author an editorial/commentary during the fellowship.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

The fellowship is open to Singapore-based early clinician researchers from all medical disciplines who are currently in Residency/Senior Residency training, or who are no more than two years from completion of Residency/Senior Residency. The candidate should have a keen interest in research and some research experience, including having published at least 1 original research article as a first author.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Fellows will be paired with an editorial team member for mentorship throughout the fellowship. They will receive coaching on reviewing research manuscripts and be invited to review manuscripts in their field of expertise (1–2 manuscripts per month).
- They will attend monthly meetings with the Editor-in-Chief and Deputy Editors to discuss manuscripts, as well as Editorial Board meetings once or twice a year.
- Where appropriate, fellows will be invited to co-author a commentary or editorial with their mentor.
- Fellows will be acknowledged on the journal website and receive a certificate on completion of the fellowship.
- Majority of the program and mentorship will be remote/online.

From January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.



APPLICATION

To apply, send an email (subject: 'SMJ Editorial Fellowship') to the Editor-in-Chief at smj@sma.org.sg along with the following:

- An updated CV
- A cover letter of no more than 500 words describing your interest in the fellowship, its potential impact on your career, and what you hope to gain from it
- A letter of recommendation from your programme director, supervisor, or a senior faculty member

Application closes on November 15, 2024. Selected applicants will be notified of the outcome via email by December 15, 2024.
