Miscommunication, misinformation and misunderstandings lie at the heart of a vast majority of medical disputes. Litigation is often expensive, unnecessary and not conducive to building relationships, although most do not realise the extent of its adversarial nature. The stress and distress of the adversarial process often severely affects all parties – the healthcare institution or individual doctor, the patients and their families – which leads to emotional exhaustion. Even winning the case becomes scant consolation.

An alternative dispute resolution scheme that leverages mediation and arbitration is highly suitable for medical disputes. It can greatly reduce costs, save time and help preserve relationships – the win-win solution which litigation does not offer.

This symposium sheds some light on the various aspects of how mediation and arbitration can work to effectively resolve healthcare disputes. It explains the compelling offer it can provide for the majority of healthcare disputes to be resolved more amicably.
