



SMA Seminar:

Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA) Advisory Guidelines for Healthcare Sector

All organisations that engage in data activities within Singapore need to comply with the local Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA) from 2 July 2014 onwards. PDPA provides more control and confidence to consumers over the collection, use and disclosure of their personal data by organisations. Inadequate compliance or poor engagement by organisations with their consumers may invite complaints, enforcement action, or hefty penalties.*

This workshop aims to help participants understand the application of the PDPA as a baseline law underlining existing ethical and legal frameworks in the healthcare sector. It also provides an opportunity for questions and answers with invited speakers from the Personal Data Protection Commission and the Ministry of Health, on its impact on medical practices.

*Organisations may be fined up to \$10,000 for breach of the Do Not Call provisions and up to \$1 million for breach of data protection provisions under PDPA.
