## novating for Future Health

Like many other countries, Singapore is undergoing a set of profound health transitions associated with rapid demographic changes, shifts in the dominant patterns of disease, and evolving requirements for health services. Together with rising healthcare costs and relative shortages of health professionals, these changes represent very significant challenges that are likely to grow more intense in the future. They do, however, provide a "burning platform" for innovation that could eventually lead to a transformation of our systems for health promotion and healthcare delivery.

This year's SMA Lecture will explore some of the opportunities related to new healthcare delivery models, and health interventions based on our growing understanding of behavioural sciences, as well as the role that education and research can play in the transformation of our healthcare system.
