## Feedback on Newly Drafted SMC ECPS

Dear SMA member,

On 1 September 2014, the Singapore Medical Council (SMC) emailed doctors about a new draft of the SMC Ethical Code and SMC Professional Standards in Practice (ECPS).

The ECPS draft has been uploaded to the Ministry of Health's Health Professionals Access portal (https://hpass.moh.gov.sg/doctor.do). Please use your SMC user ID and password to log in and read it.

We urge all members to review the ECPS draft, as it will have significant impact on your medical practice. For example,

- 1. "ECPS are to be regarded as the minimum standards upon which your performance and behaviour may be assessed." [Introduction & Preamble, section 1(iii)]
- "The use of the words 'must', 'shall' or 'will' indicates that the standard is generally to be met, save for extenuating circumstances." [Introduction & Preamble, section 6]
- "Disciplinary procedures for professional misconduct will refer to the ECPS as setting out the standards by which you will be judged." [Part 2: Singapore Medical Council Professional Standards in Practice, section (i)]
